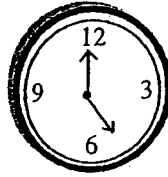


SAFETY IN PUBLIC PLACES

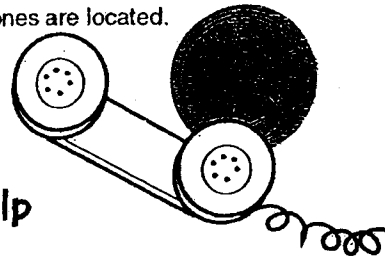
How Parents and Other Trusted Adults Can Help

- Ask permission.
- Take an adult along if you are unsure.
- Be sure to tell a parent or trusted adult where you are going and when you will return.
- Return home on time.



What You Can Do

- Carry money for a phone call. Notice where phones are located.
- Avoid dark or isolated hallways or paths.
- Go places with one or more friends.
- Stay with your friends.
- Arrange a specific meeting place and time.



How Security Personnel Can Help

- Locate the security guard station, first aid station, and other places where there is help.
- Wait for your ride inside the building. If you must wait outside, ask a security guard to wait with you.
- Ask a security guard to walk with you across any parking lots or other vacant areas, especially at night.
- If you see weapons or drugs, get to a safe place and tell a security guard, police officer, or other trusted adult.

What to Do about Strangers

- Limit conversations with strangers.
- Walk away from strangers.
- Do not give your name, address, or phone number to any stranger.
- If someone is bothering you, talk to a security guard or another adult in the area. Ask an employee in the area to call security.
